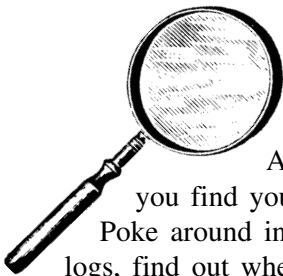

A week of adventures will lead to discoveries that will help you find your place in the natural world. You haven't seen it all.

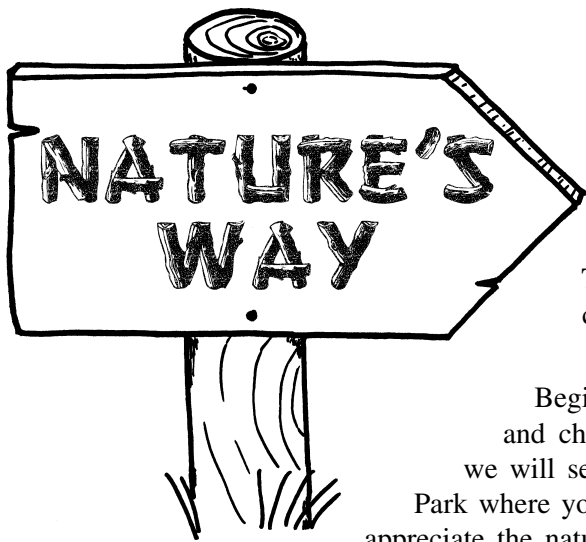
